





We were born on November 8, 1919 with the patronage of the Rotary Club of Montevideo and from there the history of Argentine Rotarianism begins, which currently has around 600 Rotary clubs in the country. We have maintained, in almost the entire century, a membership of more than 200 members and today we are 280, all opinion leaders in their respective areas. Our centennial history is riddled with events related to the life of our Republic that reverberated beyond our borders, always in accordance with the ideals of Rotary International (RI). We managed to combine the teachings in the service of helping, both in the concept of giving to the sufferer and to those who have less, with that of teaching how to achieve their growth for full development as human beings, all carried out on a plane of friendship and fellowship.

For the Centennial celebrations, our partners assumed the responsibility of carrying them out. They

all felt they were the leaders, which made it easier to organize public image activities to connect us to the world of various kinds: spiritual, cultural, educational, historical, social, sports and community action. We are grateful to *Areopagus* for inviting us to lead the last Meeting of the First Centennial and at the same time the First Meeting of the Second Centennial. At the outset, we highlight the effort made by the Administrative Secretariat that maintained the traditional weekly activities without declining (speakers, bedside table, fellows, flyers, reports, Party of the laurels, Trasandinean Award, Rioplatense Award, Best Companion Award, New Partners, Treasury, etc.) and assume all the extensive task related to the Centennial (programming, dissemination, execution) which allowed the proposal to be successfully completed and classified.



Chapter 03

Cultural Activities

One could speak of Greek culture and also of Mayan culture, of rural or industrial culture, of tango culture, of the culture of an institution, and so on indefinitely.

For this reason, it is necessary to specify in each case which culture we refer to when we mention this broad concept and, therefore, so trivialized.

Strictly speaking, the term culture comes from Latin and refers to the cultivation of the land, the iustissime tellus of the Romans. But already in its origins, Cicero extended that concept to the *cultivation of the spirit*. In other words, it would be the voluntary and constant development of man's intellectual and spiritual faculties and, at the same time, the product of that action. Man would be like this, the more perfect the more cultured he was. Ideal of perfection that was already present in Plato and in general, in all the thought of the Greek philosophers.

But remembering the etymological origin of the word culture would not go beyond being a mere illustration as long as its deep meaning was not deepened.

The cultivation of the land marks a definitive cut with the ancestral nomadism of primitive man. By working the land, man establishes himself. Settles down. Build families and villages.

It is not for nothing that the symbol of Romulus as the founder of Rome is the plow. And all of this requires effort and time, without which you could not obtain the fruits of your labor. And it also implies unraveling the rules of nature to harmonize them with its work: there is a time to sow and another to harvest, as Ecclesiastes teaches.

Culture follows that same course: it is a permanent construction that takes time and effort. It thrives on knowledge and experience and tends to achieve high moral and intellectual principles. It may be underpinned by important academic successes, but diplomas, certificates, degrees and postgraduates do not in themselves generate a cultured man. Just remember that Borges had no title.

Culture is more about *wisdom* than information. It has to do with a worldview, with a heritage of values, sometimes inherited, but always expanded and maintained by individual effort and the willingness to share and transmit it.

The fine arts, the music, the history, the readings, the taste for ideas, an enlightened life experience, the understanding of reality and a certain vision of the world that will come make the formation of a cultured man.

The Rotary Club of Buenos Aires has cultivated from its beginnings a culture of service and friendship and on those bases - solid in and of itself - it has been creating the conditions to equip its members with those cultural elements that help them along the way of a full life.

Rotary Club of Buenos Aires celebrates 100 years of history

We celebrate the first century of a noble institution dedicated to promoting the ideal of service and altruistic commitment to society

November 6, 2019

It is not common to ask about the sense of the rotary voice in English, which has no other connotation in the Spanish language than that of rotator, rotary. Rotary is the name by which Paul Harris and four other prominent members of the Chicago community resolved in 1905 to found a club designed to advance the ideal of service as the foundation of every worthy enterprise, and especially the altruistic commitment to society. With Harris's decisive inspiration, Rotarian founders have tended to global peace, racial integration and friendship based on solidarity and ethical principles between professionals of relevant role in the most diverse disciplines of human activity.

The foundation of the Rotary Club of Buenos Aires, of which

the centenary is celebrated the day after tomorrow, is a fact close to this newspaper. Jorge Adolfo Miter, who was the first president of that institution, held the leadership of LA NACION on November 8, 1919 in one of its moments of greatest expansion.

For 100 years, the Rotary of Buenos Aires has maintained a special relationship with the counterpart institution in Montevideo. It was precisely from this club, founded a year earlier, that the incentives for an equivalent initiative in our city to materialize. In this way, the strength of the links between the two and the significance accorded to the distinction that they confer in a joint manner, year after

year, on a personality with a notable career in the River Plate area are understood. In the Rotaries, as the word says, it is rotated so that the ties that unite its members are not restricted to groups among the associates and the friendship thus flows in a spiritual enrichment of each of them with all the others.

In accordance with the modality that prevails in the many dozens of countries in which the Rotarian spirit is present, these clubs act independently and independently of the political or religious party systems; they are only interested in propagating harmony among human beings, without discrimination of any kind.

Just as there are other Rotaries in the interior of the country, that of Buenos Aires has been the patron of the foundation of similar entities, of a neighborhood order, in the city where it is based. The list of charities in which the Rotary of Buenos Aires has been involved is vast. It is still participating in an old campaign aimed at eradicating childhood paralysis. His achievements have been important, but he continues to collaborate in this field, since there are still African countries where this evil is present.

It has also been a means of substantial support for the delivery of medical instruments where their assistance has been required. He has also made contributions to the reopening of the Chil-

> dren's Endocrinology room of the Ricardo Gutiérrez Children's Hospital and annually grants subsidies to the Diana School for hearing impaired children.

The Tognoni scholarship, which comes from a significant donation, allows an Argentine professional to consolidate his training in first-rate foreign universities. His contributions to public education have been known since he promoted, in 1927, the creation of the Argentine Association of English Culture (Icana). No less outstanding has been the participation of the Rotary of Buenos Aires in the negotiations that led to peace, in 1935, in the Chaco Boreal war, between Paraguay and Bolivia; to cease fire in 1995 in

the confrontation between Peruvians and Ecuadorians, and to calm in 2006 the disagreements between Uruguay and the government of Néstor Kirchner over the Botnia paper mill, which could have settled in our country if the intelligence with which it had been different National interests were articulated here. We join, for all that said, the celebration of the first hundred years of an institution of associative principles that Argentines would do well to emulate more than they have done, for its invaluable contribution and solidarity among us.

Una rueda que no se detiene

La historia y los secretos del Rotary Club de Buenos Aires, una organización con más de 100 años en la Argentina.

Nació en 1937 en España, durante la Guerra Civil. A los tres años, su familia se instaló en Chaco, Argentina, en una región llamada "Pampa del Infierno". Recibido de médico por la UBA en 1959, se convirtió en eminencia de cirugía y, en 1998, presidente de la Asociación de Médicos de Argentina (AMA), donde fue reelecto en cinco oportunidades. Operó durante seis décadas y entre sus pacientes tuvo a varios expresidentes, como Raúl Alfonsín y Fernando de la Rúa. Pero, además de todas esas cucardas. Elías Hurtado Hovo es el presidente del Rotary Club Buenos Aires, entidad que el año pasado cumplió 100 años en la Argentina.

El Rotary Club tiene una idea fuerza: promover acciones en beneficio de la comunidad. "¿Qué hacemos? Nos juntamos para hacer actividades sociales. Somos una ONG de servicio para quienes lo solicitan. Apoyamos al que menos tiene", explica Hurtado Hoyo desde su oficina, donde la rueda dentada, el símbolo del Rotary, tiene un lugar prominente. Para poder cumplir con su misión de ayuda, todos los socios pagan una cuota mensual y una comida semanal, concurran o no.

A nivel mundial, el Rotary le debe su nacimiento a Paul Percy Harris, quien lo fundó en febrero de 1905 en Chicago, Estados Unidos. La expansión fue, primero, en ese país. En 1916, Heriberto Percival Coates, un comerciante uruguayo que viajaba a Estados Unidos por cuestiones comerciales, decidió expandir la entidad en Sudamérica y plantó bandera del Rotary Club Montevideo

en 1918 — el primero debajo de la línea del Ecuador. De hecho, es el padrino del club local, inaugurado en 1919 y del cual su primer presidente fue Jorge Mitre, en ese entonces director de La Nación. Después llegó la expansión en el país, en Rosario, La Plata, Córdoba, Mendoza y Bahía Blanca — hoy, en la Argentina hay alrededor de 599 clubes en los distritos en los que participan más de 9600 socios. En el mundo, son 1,2 millones.

Los miembros del Rotary en la Argentina son, mayormente, profesionales con trayectoria en sus disciplinas. Para sumarse es solo por invitación y el candidato tiene que ser presentado por un socio, que aporta además su currículum. "Después, una junta evaluadora lo tamiza y se les consulta a los demás socios. Depende la época, el proceso puede llevar entre cuatro y seis meses", cuenta Hurtado Hoyo.

Su principal foco, las acciones para promover mejoras en la sociedad, data desde cuando Harris promovió que los clubes hicieran y entregaran sillas de ruedas, o una campaña de vacunación efectiva contra la poliomielitis. El Rotary también fue clave para terminar con la guerra de Paraguay y Bolivia por la región del Chaco, cuenta Hurtado Hoyo. El artífice fue Carlos Saavedra Lamas, entonces ministro de Relaciones Exteriores de la Argentina y miembro del Rotary, que recibió el Premio Nobel de la Paz en 1936. Entre sus acciones locales, realizan donaciones a hospitales, otorgan becas de estudio y donaron 250 filtros de agua en Santiago del Estero.

"Lo que siempre destaco de este país es la educación. Pero se fue degradando v en los niveles más bajos es donde más repercutió. Un educador, además de enseñar una temática, es formador de personas. Y se educa con el ejemplo", asegura Hurtado Hoyo, quien concluve: "Pero la educación no es solo de las escuelas, sino de la familia. Hubo una fuerte degradación de la educación, la policía, el empleo público... La gente aprendió a sobrevivir. Hay una patología que hicieron no uno, sino todos los gobiernos. Eso es lo que hemos perdido. No se puede asumir un cargo público para ir a aprender en la función, porque cuando termina de aprender se está yendo y llega otro. Sé que esto es duro". <AP> F.R.

Our RCBA has a long tradition of supporting the community in multiple areas, such as health, education, and other areas where we identify aid needs. In the year of our **Centennial** we have wanted to renew our efforts so that the contributions of our Club acquire a relevance in accordance with this historic celebration.

Among the **donations made by RCBA** during this period 2019/2020 it is worth mentioning:


Our vision was to promote in young people not only the interest and love for reading and writing, but also

10. Scholarships

RCBA Scholarships for Secondary Studies

As usual, also during the Centennial year, the Club delivered **70 scholarships for students studying secondary school from first to sixth year** (some up to fifth, depending on the modality), for an amount of \$8400.- to each student in 4 installments distributed throughout the year, the first with their enrollment as a regular student and the remaining three against the delivery of their report card.

The staff of the Secretariat maintained direct contact with them, since the condition to obtain and maintain said "prizes" is to maintain good grades and remain with the concern and curiosity to continue learning, until they are received.

In the cases in which their grades fell, each individual student was treated and it was recommended to use the money for a particular support and thus not lose their stimulus / scholarship. It was not a simple process of giving them money, but rather being aware of the reality of each and their personal achievements, often facing adversity.

These students all come from humble homes and were originally proposed by the primary schools that the RCBA sponsors and are within our radius of action.

The expense that the entity faced to continue this important project was supported by entities such as the Argentine Medical Association and prominent Rotarians such as EDRI Carlos E. Speroni. Likewise, the members Jorge Ader, Guillermo Arteta, Juan José Ávila, Eduardo Becher (2 scholarships), Alberto Bieule, Enrique Braun Estrugamou, Eduardo Cartasso Naveyra, Daniel Charles, Gustavo Criscuolo, Julián De Diego, Federico Eijo, Juan Flemming, Jorge Grinpelc, Diego Ibarbia, Juan Insua, Alfredo Iribarren, Mauro Keller Sarmiento, Juan E. Llamazares, Alejandro Marolda, Miguel Maxwell, Luis Ovsejevich, Luis Prudent, Winfried Rohde (+), Manuel Sacerdote (2 scholarships), Pedro Simoncini (2 scholarships) and Martín Sucari (4 scholarships).

The Committee for Pro Youth Activities, Scholarships and Student Loans, chaired -during the Centennial year- by the consortium Gabriel Astarloa, was in charge of talking with the applicants and finding out about their basic needs, their family environment, the work situation of their parents or guardians, as well as the applicant was asked for a letter explaining their motivations (what will they use the scholarship for? ? What studies do you want to do? If you are planning to study a tertiary or university degree at the end of your secondary cycle? Etc).

This letter was attached to the file of each fellow.

In this Rotary exercise that coincided with the 100 years of the Rotary Club of Buenos Aires, approximately 7 students finished their secondary studies, who were supported throughout their process and absolutely all of them expressed interest in continuing to study.




Chapter 13

We want to share with Rotary friends the **Income** and **Expenses** table corresponding to the celebration of the Centennial of the Rotary Club of Buenos Aires.

The presidents of the 2018/19 and 2019/20 periods assumed the responsibility of organizing different events.

At the start of the 2919/20 financial year, a specific fund had been raised for the equivalent of about \$27,000. The preparation of the **Centennial Book** had also started during the presidency of Ubaldo Aguirre. A team of several partners followed this topic under the coordination of Juan Javier Negri, Raúl José Romero, Juan E. Llamazares and Roberto Martínez.

Throughout the management of Elías Hurtado Hoyo and Eduardo Chehtman, who held more than thirty spiritual, sports, artistic and literary meetings. The Gala Dinner and Anniversary Party was organized for more than 600 people in the "Central de la Sociedad Rural Argentina" Restaurant, as well as three cocktails for

three hundred people.

Two high-ranking catalogs were also published.

The necessary funds equivalent to about \$ 70,000 were collected during this period to complete the financing.

We must highlight the collaboration of all the Club staff, who added their effort to make the celebrations a success.

As can be seen in the report, the reserves of the RCBA were avoided due to the care with which the expenses were made, donations from members, some special contributions from benefactor members, various sponsors, book sales and some souvenirs.

The Club authorities are pleased to present this summary and reiterate their gratitude to Rotarian partners and employees who, with their contributions of all kinds, made the Centennial celebrations a success, despite the difficult economic circumstances that the Argentine economy was going through. We must clarify that there is a remnant of more than 470 books for sale to partners and third parties or as a gift to guests.

Although the project of events for the Centennial of the Rotary Club of Buenos Aires has been self-sustaining, according to the decisions taken between both Boards of Directors (Presidency of Ing. Ubaldo Aguirre and Presidency of Dr. Elías Hurtado Hoyo) the result of the same has produced a small negative balance, which was covered with the exchange difference resulting from the sale of dollars collected on the occasion of said events, but reserving a large amount in that currency, which helped to increase the savings that are deposited in the HSBC Bank safe deposit box on behalf of the Rotary Club of Buenos Aires.

There are 470 **Centennial Books** left in the secretariat which will serve as various services or to be marketed to Rotarians in other districts or abroad. Each member contributed US \$ 60 dollars for his book.


